All cases must be active. Case type must be 'refugee'.

Report start and end dates are applied as follows:

- R&P Arrivals section arrival date
- R&P Period Report section arrival date.
- MG section 180<sup>th</sup> day

For inclusion in the R&P Period Report section, all R&P Period Reports must be accepted by the RA and sent to RPC.

Affiliates must have a status of "Active". URM sites are not included.
