<p>Biodata Import</p> <p>Resolved issue with biodata import that was related to Minor Report Suitability Determination restrictions. Specifically, code to remove a Minor Report when a Minor Code was changing to an M4 needed to be moved to a different section of the code so that it didn't produce an error.</p>	Bug	216566
<p>P3 & CAM AORs – Signatures screen</p> <p>Changed the field used to determine Affiliate address (Org ID rather than FirstPendingUserID) to make it consistent with how Affiliate address is determined for the DS-7656 & DS-7699 forms.</p>	Enhancement	215709
<p>WRAPS Export – File Type</p> <p>“Export Interest Files” has been removed from the WRAPS Export “File Type” dropdown because it is an obsolete feature that is no longer used.</p>	Enhancement	214936
<p>WRAPS Import – Summary screen</p> <p>Resolved issue where the “Close” button was not working on the WRAPS Import Summary screen.</p>	Bug	214936
<p>TEST IRIS ONLY – RA Case Note attachments</p> <p>When Test data is refreshed with Prod data, IRIS Support usually doesn't copy over files in order to save time and space. It used to be that if you clicked on an attachment in an RA Case Note and the file did not exist in the database, IRIS would present a blank, white pop-up screen. Now the absent file will be grayed out, alerting you that the file is not in the database.</p>	Enhancement	214936
<p>Assurance Ready Email Notification</p> <p>This optional email notification was sending multiple emails to the email recipient.</p> <p>A second bug was only sending the email if affiliate assured the email after midnight. Email will now be sent, the morning after the affiliate makes the case 'ready to assure'.</p>	Bug	216189
<p>Import WRAPS Medical Note File</p> <p>New feature to import WRAPS “MN” files. Note, unlike other medical file imports, WRAPS MN zip files may contain files with duplicated file names. IRIS has an exception for MN files to allow the import of files even if a file with that name already exists.</p>	Enhancement	216260
<p>AOR Activity Notification</p>	Bug	217411

Affiliate version: IRIS should only be highlighting rows where an Activity that requires acknowledgement has not been acknowledged within a week. However, IRIS was highlighting all rows after a week, even ones that did not require acknowledgement. This has been resolved. RA version: Fixed issue where AORs were not dropping off the RA's AOR Activity Notification after 14 days.
